The President additionally specially appointed four people, then one member died in Jan. 2014. There were 23 members specially appointec during this session.
(5)The twelfth Examination Yuan's 19 Commissioners were sworn in on September 1, 2014 who were all nominated by the President of the Republic of China. One member resigned and The President additionally specia appointed one people. There were 20 members specially appointed during this session.
(6)The thirteenth Examination Yuan's 9 Commissioners(7 initial appointments, 2 reappointments) were sworn in on September 1, 2020 who were all nominated by the President of the Republic of China.
